

PSYCHOLOGY (BA) + OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY (MS)

Students interested in pursuing degrees in Psychology and Occupational Therapy may do so through this unique combined program which may be completed in just over five years. Interested students apply to enter DePaul's Occupational Therapy program in their first year of study and if accepted, they begin coursework in Occupational Therapy in their fourth year. Students have a choice of two concentrations in Psychology to pursue this path: Standard or Human Development.
